The Heathrow Jobs & Careers Fair is a great opportunity for local young people to connect with employers, training providers, and volunteer organisations, and learn all about the range of career paths at Heathrow.

Over 75,800 people work for over 400 companies at Heathrow. The airport offers a whole host of employment opportunities including airline staff, security personnel, ground crews, fire and police officers, engineers, construction workers, caterers and retail staff.

People from all types of backgrounds with a whole host of skills are on hand to ensure the safe arrival and departure of **over 190,000 passengers a day** across five terminals.

Heathrow encourages companies operating at the airport to recruit local people from **Ealing, Hillingdon, Hounslow, Slough and Spelthorne** and help them gain the relevant qualifications. **Over half of the people employed at Heathrow live locally.**

Did you know...

The airport's cafés and restaurants boil, fry, scramble, whisk and soufflé more than 100 million eggs each year.

Heathrow sells 26,000 cups of tea and 35,000 cups of coffee every day.

A bottle of Chanel No.5 is sold at World Duty Free every nine minutes.

The site on which Heathrow stands was first developed in 1930 as an aircraft test site with a single grass runway.

The initial British Airways flight, taking off from Hounslow Heath, carried a single passenger and cargo including newspapers, Devonshire cream and grouse.


